There is Power in the Blood

Recently I was listening to the hymn by Lewis E. Jones called "There is Power in the Blood" and I began to think of how much the message of Christianity centers around the blood of Christ. Peter writes that we have been purchased not with the money of this world but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without any imperfections. John writes "Behold the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world" and the significance of that statement is seen at the cross as Jesus hangs there shedding His blood in sacrifice for our sins. The Hebrew writer explains that the Old Testament sacrificial system of the shedding of the blood of bulls and goats as an offering for sin was simply pointing to the supreme sacrifice of Christ. The blood that the high priests of Israel carried into the Most Holy Place did not have the power to perfect their conscience but only served as a means of pointing to the One who would enter into the Holiest Place with His own blood which would have the power to bring us eternal redemption. Paul writes that we have redemption through the blood of Christ, the forgiveness of our sins. Here is where the power of the blood of Christ is demonstrated: our sins are forgiven. The song writer poses the question "Would you be free from the burden of sin?" and then answers, "there is power in the blood." The blood of Christ speaks of cleansing, forgiveness, restoration, and ultimately salvation.

The psalmist speaks of the power of the blood of Christ powerfully in Psalm 103 KJV <A Psalm of David.> "Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's. The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed. He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel. The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever. He hath not dealt with

us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us. Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him. For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we are dust. As for man, his days are as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth. For the wind passeth over it, and it is gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more. But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them. The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all. Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure. Bless the LORD, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless the LORD, O my soul."

The blood of Christ has paid the ransom price for our sins forever. All that the psalmist speaks of has been accomplished by the blood offering of Christ. The blood of Christ speaks to us of the mercy and forgiveness of our God. We read also in Romans 3:23-26 *For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus."* Paul writes here that through faith in the blood of Christ our sins have been atoned. It is Christ who has become the sacrifice for sin in order to redeem our lives from destruction. It is His blood that had the power to remove our sins from us as far as the east is from the west. No other blood could do this, in fact the old covenant sacrifices served as a reminder of the sinfulness of the people. The blood

of Christ has however set us apart as holy forever. We are indeed made perfect by the blood of Christ and now have boldness to enter into the Holiest place. My friends, every day we walk under the covering of this blood. The scripture speaks of this blood continually as we read also in Revelation 5:9-10 *“And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.”*

There is indeed power in the blood of Christ my friends, hear its message and walk out from under that burden you are carrying. There is no need for you to continue to carry it for the Great Burden Carrier has already removed it from your shoulders. His blood has been shed once and for all. The payment has been made and God is satisfied! Believe it and live as the free children of God because there is *“Power in the Blood.”*

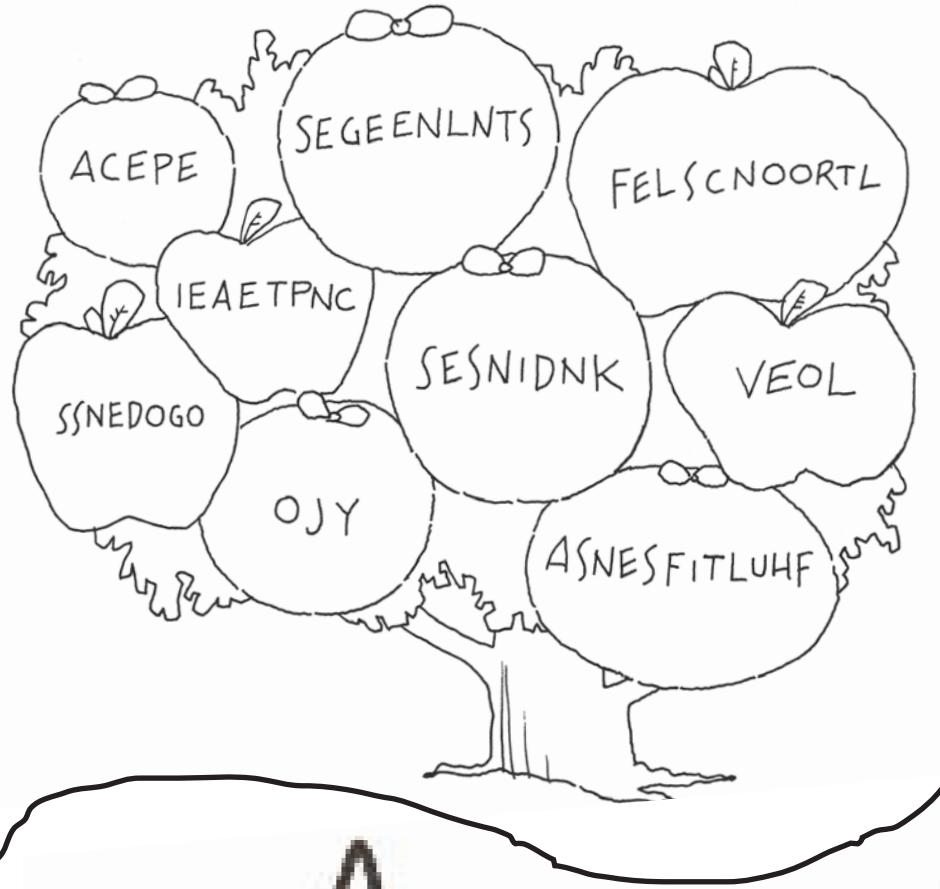

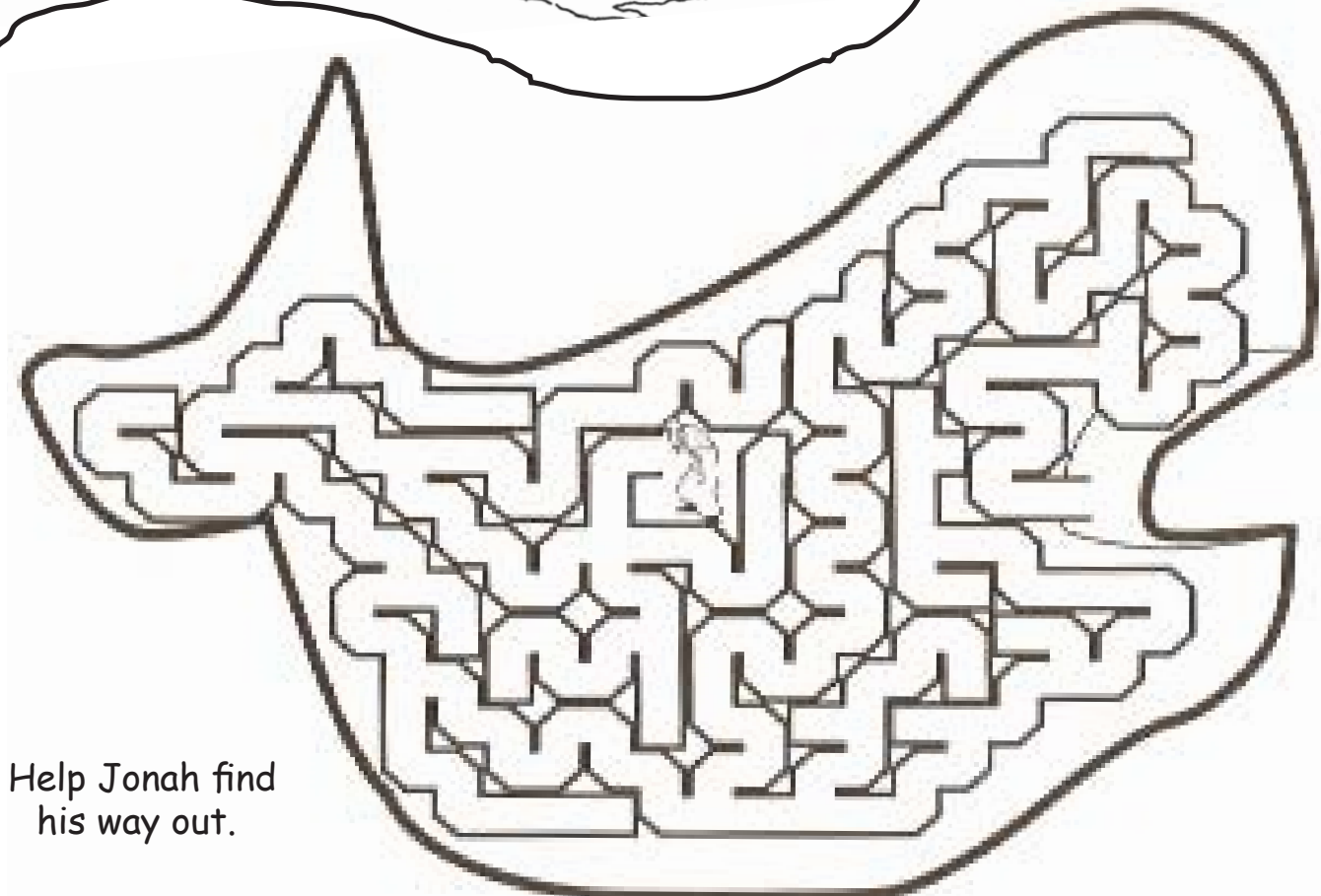
