We pray that they would know the exceeding greatness of His power to all who believe, according to the working of His mighty power. We pray that they would see this power through the power of the resurrection. We pray that they would constantly be drawn to the risen Lord Jesus who God raised from the dead and set at His own right hand in the heavenly places. We pray that they would understand clearly what they possess in Christ Jesus and how they are part of His body. We pray that they would live constantly with the understanding of who they are and who they belong to. They are the loved children of the most High God and are part of the body of Christ. He has saved them by His grace. So, we continue to pray for our graduates. We pray that Christ may dwell in their hearts by faith, and that they would be rooted and grounded in love, comprehending with all the saints the breadth, length, depth, height, and to know the love of Christ that surpassed knowledge, so that they would be filled with the fullness of God. Amen and Amen.


