Run With Endurance

Hebrews 12:1-2 ¹ "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, ² Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God."

The Hebrew writer after listing all of the children of God who walked by faith in chapter 11, the chapter often referred to as the Hall of Faith, tells us that we are to lay aside the weights of this life and the sin that clings to us so closely, and to run with patience or endurance the race that is before us. Often when I read this passage in Hebrews, I am reminded of an event in my life that illustrates this running with endurance. I attended the Rindge Memorial School which was the grade school (K-5) in my hometown of Rindge, NH. My buddies and I always enjoyed recess time at school, probably my favorite subject, and we often had foot races to see who the fastest runner was. At the end of the school year there was an event called Track and Field Day in which there was the 50 yard dash, long jump, and other events. The final event was something we called the "Road Race" which took place on the street in front of the school and the whole school would gather on the front lawn of the school to observe the race. The runners would start about 1/4 mile from the school and race to the finish line which was roughly about the center of the school yard. There was always a banner stretched across the road that the 1st runner would break through thus winning the race. I always did well in the race, usually finishing 2nd or 3rd, and getting a ribbon as there was a ribbon for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers. I remember one year in particular, we lined up on the starting line

as usual and when the gun sounded off, I took off in my usual way, I would never take off at full speed but would pace myself as the road we were running on started off flat at first and then climbed uphill to the school, flattening out in front of the school. I would start running at a slower pace at the back of the runners, so that when I got to the hill I would be able to endure the climb and run harder passing the other runners making my way to the front of the pack. That is what happened on that day and as I got closer to the school, I realized I was in the lead. I was in first place and there on the lawn of the school were the students, teachers, and parents cheering us on. They were like the witnesses we read about in the above verses cheering me on toward the finish line. I remember that my uncle was there on the lawn, and he was pointing behind me and telling me to run harder as there was someone gaining on me. As you draw nearer to the finish line of a race, it can be easy to be distracted by the crowds and or the other runners. He wanted me to focus on the finish line and to run as hard as I could in order to win. I am not sure I was able to run any harder, but I was able to endure and win the race. As we run the race of life, we are always in need of those who come along side of us to encourage us. My uncle wanted to see me win the race and was encouraging me to that end. As we run the race of life, we are encouraged not to muster up the last bit of our strength, but to endure by looking to the One who will get us across the finish line, Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith. Looking unto Jesus we can run with endurance and in Him we will win or maybe better said we have won. As we run the race of life, let us always focus on our Savior the Lord Jesus Christ.
